





Joint Information Center Wednesday, October 7, 2020

As of 10 a.m. on Wednesday, Oct. 7, Calhoun County has a cumulative total of 1,503 confirmed cases of COVID-19 reported to Calhoun County Public Health Department (CCPHD), with a total of 48 deaths attributed to the virus. This information is updated once daily, Monday through Friday, at www.calhouncountymi.gov.



Information about Halloween in Calhoun County

Neighbors are carving pumpkins and hanging cobwebs in anticipation of Halloween, and Calhoun County leaders want to share information about celebrating this haunted holiday safely.

- **Homer** – Official trick-or-treat hours 5-7 p.m. Oct. 31
- **Marshall** – No set trick-or-treat hours or Halloween regulations; **NO** downtown costume parade or Fire Department candy checks this year
