

FREEZING PIPES

The Village of Homer Department of Public Works would like to express their concerns with the possibility of extreme cold and freezing water pipes. During the upcoming cold spell the D.P.W. is suggesting that if your home or business has had previous issues with frozen pipes, that you run a pencil stream of water through them until the cold spell is finished. One of the early signs of possible frozen pipes is if your water becomes suddenly rusty in color. If you experience this “rusty water” run your water until it becomes clear.
